Items included with both options for 3 Day and 6 Day Family Camps

- Wooded campsite with modern restrooms and showers nearby
- Fire circle, dry firewood, picnic table
- Utility hookups available: electric, water, and sewer
- Coin operated laundry facility nearby
- Emergency shelter nearby

RV Park Rental Accessory: Family Tent & Equipment

Cabela Deluxe Backwoods Tent 10' X 20' – comfortably sleeps family of six with room to spare.

Three separate rooms: Two end rooms each sleep 3 very comfortably with common room in middle



Equipment provided with additional fee: \$35/3 Day camp, \$70/6 Day camp

- Three-room Family Style Tent 10' X 20' set up and ready for use (includes rain fly)
- Two cots, two folding lawn chairs, sleeping mats as needed
- Outside door mat, three inside throw rugs
- Rain tarp over picnic table
- Electricity and water included
- Clothesline, utility towels, dustpan and hand broom

Option 1) With Meals

- Your meals will be provided for in the camp dining hall

Option 2) No Meals

- **Cooking & Table Gear:** (No cooking in tent)
 - Gas or propane stove, wood matches or lighter
 - Wash tubs, rags, scouring pad, towels
 - Drying rack or hammock
 - Coffee pot, pans, pots, and cooking utensils
 - Dish and hand soap, paper towels, hand towels
 - Roasting sticks, tin foil
 - Plates, mugs, silverware, lap trays (optional)
 - Salt, pepper, various seasonings, condiments
- **Food:**
 - Two large coolers: 1-Frozen, 1-Cool
 - Totes for dry and canned food storage
 - Create a daily meal planning guide
 - Food supply per your planning guide

Items recommended/suggested to bring for both options

• Family Gear

- Duffle bag or tote for family gear
- Health insurance information / first aid kit
- Camera, video recorder
- Bug spray, suntan screen, sunburn lotion
- Blankets, extra throw rugs,
- Cards, table games, pencils paper
- Spending money for stores and crafts

• Campfire snack gear:

- Tote for campfire snack gear
- Outdoor lamps: Propane, battery, or electric
- Wooden matches or lighter, news paper
- Campfire coffee pot / liquid dish soap
- Roasting sticks, mugs, spoons
- Smores: marshmallows, graham crackers, Hershey's chocolate bar
- Coffee, teas, hot chocolate

• Sports Items

- Bikes (camp has adult bike rentals)
- Water toys
- Extra lawn chairs
- Frisbee, or disc golf set
- Football, nerf ball
- Fishing gear (please do not bring your own watercraft)
- Wisconsin fishing license

• Personal Gear

- Duffle bag
- Sleeping bag, pillow, teddy bear?
- Bath and shower kit bag
- Towel and wash cloth
- Flip Flops, slip-ons, or similar item
- Sun glasses
- Hat with brim, poncho or rain coat w/hood,
- LED cap light - brim style
- Bible, books to read
- Plan clothing accordingly

 - Clothing for cool/wet weather
 - Clothing for warm/sunny weather
